BOURG-LA-REINE, A SPORTS CITY

Bourg-la-Reine was labeled «Terre de Jeux 2024» by the Paris Olympic and Paralympic Games Organizing Committee. This distinction highlights the city's desire to be part of a high-level sporting approach.

Indeed, our fencing and para judo clubs won no less than five medals at the Tokyo 2020 Olympic and Paralympic Games. To support them, Bourg-la-Reine has undertaken major renovation and extension work on the Bas-Coquarts sports center complex, which will make it one of the largest fencing and judo training centers at the national level.

This project also aims to include Bourg-la-Reine and its inhabitants in the Olympic and Paralympic dynamics of Paris 2024. A real green setting in the heart of Paris, the city will not fail to attract you with its relaxing and friendly aspect.

For many years, Bourg-la-Reine has been spreading best practices in sports: accessibility for people with disabilities, promotion of gender equality. With these few lines, we wish to share our motivation with you. Welcome your delegation would make all of our inhabitants very proud.

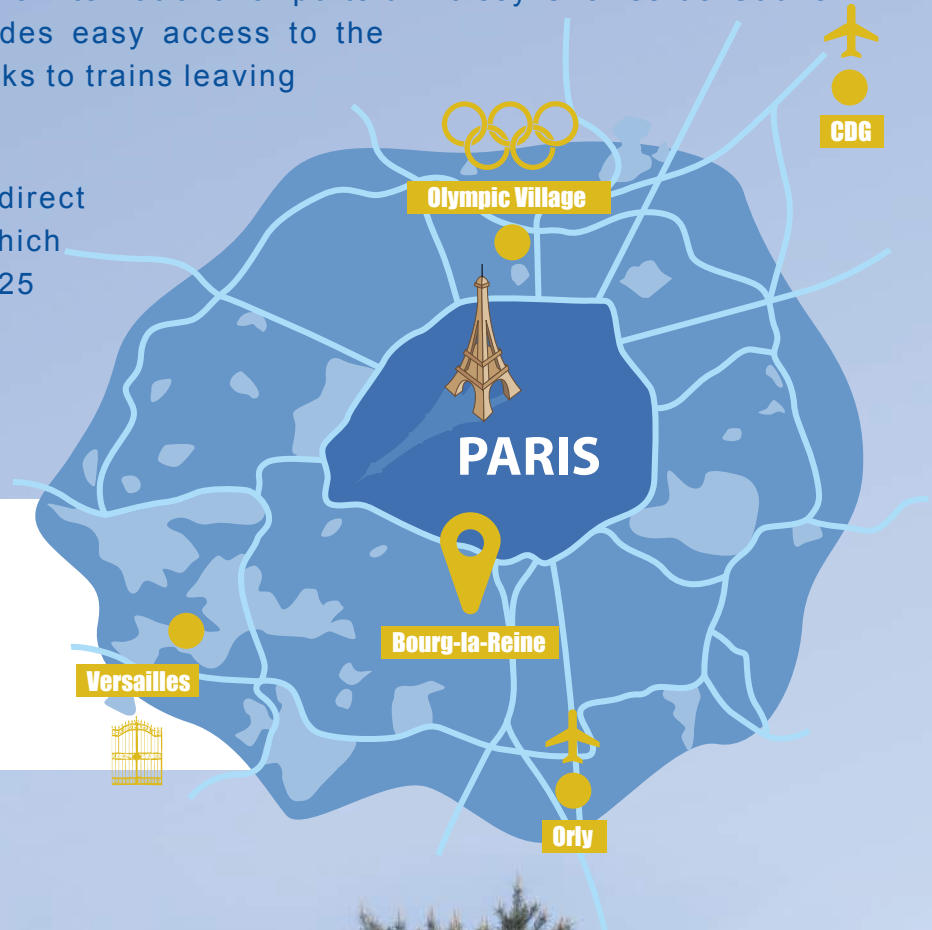

A real green setting near Paris, Bourg-la-Reine benefits from transportation that place the city at the heart of Paris area. The municipality is attractive for its dynamism, its rejuvenating living environment, but also for its top sports infrastructure level.

Located at 4km from Paris, Bourg-la-Reine provides easy access to sports facilities, as well as the Olympic Village. Bourg-la-Reine is desserved by all the trains of the RERB line which connects the two international airports of Roissy-Charles-de-Gaulle and Orly. The RERB line provides easy access to the heart of Paris in 20 minutes thanks to trains leaving every 3 minutes.

Bourg-la-Reine also has a direct access to the A86 motorway, which allows to reach Versailles in 25 minutes by the road.

A CITY OF EXCELLENCE

Like its five Olympic medalists and its two world champions, Bourg-la-Reine aims for excellence in sport. The city will eventually have one of the largest training centers for fencing and para judo at the national level.

The Organizing Committee of the Olympic and Paralympic Games of Paris 2024 awarded the label "Terre de jeux" to Bourg-la-Reine, which was one of the 500 first labeled cities. This distinction is awarded to public authorities that are committed to carry out and undertake actions linked to Olympic and Paralympic Games.

A LIVING ENVIRONMENT THAT ENABLES SPORTS PERFORMANCE

Located near the « Parc départemental de Sceaux » (Sceaux Park), Bourg-la-Reine offers athletes a rejuvenating living environment (220 hectares of green spaces), secure and easy to access.

In terms of town planning, Bourg-la-Reine identifies itself as the city of tomorrow: all the daily services are accessible by foot or by bike. Bourg-la-Reine is committed to the protection of the environment and takes care its plants heritage: development of soft circulations, plans protective urban planning, awareness of its inhabitants to ecology.

Built in the 19th century, the Sceaux castle is surrounded by a magnificent park with beautiful fountains. In the summer, the Orangerie hosts a famous music festival, the Festival de l'Orangerie.

A VERY HIGH-LEVEL TRAINING CENTER

Close to the heart of the city, the Bas-Coquarts sports complex is an essential place for practicing sports and gathers a lot of different sports activities such as fencing and martial arts (judo, karate, taekwondo, nanbudo, etc.).

The city, with the supports of the State, the Île-de-France region and the Hauts-de-Seine department, undertook in 2022 the rehabilitation and extension of its sports complex to enable athletes to train in a spacious, aesthetic and high-quality facilities.

From June 2023, the new extension of 2,670 m² will host in particular:

- a new fencing hall which will include 20 fencing pistes (including 14 that can accommodate international-level competitions), peripheral circulation and clearance areas,
- a retractable stand with a capacity of 100 people,
- a space dedicated to martial arts which will include three combat areas (8x8m), peripheral and clearance circulation, as well as a retractable stand

All these new facilities are easy accessible to people with disabilities.

For the comfort of the athletes, the renovation works also provide a reception area, a physical preparation room, a recovery room, a video room, a meeting room, as well as a space for relaxation and conviviality (clubhouse).





IT HAPPENED IN BOURG-LA-REINE!

Many sports events have already been held within the Bas Coquarts sports complex. BLR92 fencing club, which is a leading club for the city and the department, welcomes every year an international fencing challenge which gathers best fencers in the world. In January 2020, «the day dedicated to disabled sports» welcomed around 50 people with disabilities. The sports complex also hosted, in 2016, a national boxing tournament, as well as the “Paris World Games” events in July 2019.

The Bas-Coquarts sports complex is surrounded three hospitals, as well as a medical center specialized in the follow-up of high-level athletes, all located within 4 km. The city has also a medical imaging center located in heart of town.

- in order to discover French gastronomy, you will also be able to dine at the restaurant, "Le Trévise" located in the heart of the « Parc départemental de Sceaux » (Sceaux Park)
